

Community RSS Feed

RSS ('Really Simple Syndication' or 'Rich Site Summary') is a family of web feed formats used to publish frequently updated works such as blog entries, news headlines, audio, and video in a standardized format.

An RSS document ('feed', 'web feed' or 'channel') includes full or summarized text plus metadata such as publishing dates and authorship.

Web feeds benefit publishers by letting them syndicate content automatically. They benefit readers who want to subscribe to timely updates from favored websites or to aggregate feeds from many sites into one place.

RSS feeds can be read using software called an 'RSS readers', 'feed readers', or 'aggregators', which can be web-based, desktop-based, or mobile based. Reed more at wikipedia.org about RSS.

All Xsdot community components (User lists, Messaging containers, Blogs, Forums, Message views, Chats) implement RSS feeds. The RSS feeds can be customized by using Xsdot's templates systems.
